

FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT

God's covenant with Noah when he was delivered from the flood. (Genesis 9)

The waters of the flood prefigured the baptism which now saves you. (1 Peter 3)

Jesus was tempted by Satan; and the Angels waited on him.

These 40 days of Lent are the Spirit's call to us to a "desert experience," to re-connect with God, to dare to wonder if our lives are all they could and should be.

Lent calls us away from business as usual (the real motivation behind giving up one's

favorite confection or past time) in order to decide, in the depths of our hearts where God speaks to each one of us, what it means to be a person of faith, what values we want our lives to stand for, what path we want our lives to take on our journey to God and Easter resurrection.

As Jesus spent 40 days in the wilderness to discern what God was calling him to do with the next part of his life, the Spirit calls us to our own "wilderness experience" to confront the hard choices we must make in our lives – choices between the values of God and the far lesser things of the world that can isolate us, hurt others and diminish God's creation.
