The gift of the Holy Spirit was poured out even on the Gentiles. (Acts 10)

Whoever does not love does not know God, for God is love. *(1 John 4)* 

No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends. (*John 15*)



This is the commandment that Jesus to us who would be his Church: to love one another as Jesus, God made human, has loved us: As Christ gave himself for others, we are to imitate his example of service to others; as Christ brought

healing and peace into the lives of those he encountered, we are to bring that same healing and peace into the many lives we touch; as Christ revealed to

the world a God who loves humanity as a parent loves his children, we are to love one another as brothers and sisters.

Christ transforms creation's relationship with its Creator. God is not a distant, aloof, removed architect of the universe; God is not the cruel taskmaster; God is not the unfeeling judge who seeks the destruction of the wicked. God is creative, reconciling, energizing love - and Jesus is the perfect expression of that love.

All that God has done in the first creation of Genesis and the re-creation of Easter has been done out of the limitless, unfathomable love of God. Such love invites us not to fear God but to accept his "friendship" with God, not to selfloathing at our unworthiness but to grateful joy at what God has done in us.


